

Local Government Act 1972 – Section 214 & Schedule 26 Cemeteries and Crematoria Local Authorities' Cemeteries Order 1977

Great Shelford Parish Council, being the Burial Authority for the Parish of Great Shelford for the purposes and having the function given to it by, the provisions of the above mentioned Act and Order, at its meeting of 8th November 2021 fixed and settled the following fees in connection with burials in Great Shelford Cemetery.

The person to be interred or in respect of whom the right is granted must be before their death, a past or present inhabitant or parishioner of the Parish of Great Shelford or in the case of a still-born child, where one of the parents is, or at the time of interment was, such an inhabitant or parishioner.

EXCLUSIVE RIGHT OF BURIAL (plot purchase)

For 99 years in an earthen Grave 2 metres by 1 metre	£275.00
For 99 years in an earthen Grave, double depthf	£450.00
For 99 years of cremated remains in an earthen grave 600mm by 600mm	£125.00

INTERMENT

Intermentf	2225.00
Interment of ashesf	£125.00

The fees indicated above do not include the digging of the grave.

MONUMENTS, GRAVESTONES, TABLETS & MONUMENTAL INSCRIPTIONS

For the right to erect or place on a grave in respect of which the exclusive right of burial has been granted:

A headstone not exceeding 1.35 metres in height£225	·.UU
A vase or tablet not exceeding 750mm in height£225	.00
A cross of hardwood not exceeding 600mm in height and 610mm in width£225	.00
A flat kerb not exceeding 7 inches x 3 inches£245	.00
A flat tablet not exceeding 300mm by 400mm£245	.00
The Memorial Garden – Small stones size not to exceed 35cm by 40cm placed flat in the ground, at ground level£215	.00
(The fees indicated in Part 3 above include the first inscription) Each additional inscription thereafter£140	00

No memorial may be erected until the design and inscription have been approved by the Parish Clerk. No alterations may be made to any existing memorial without consent from the Clerk.
