
GREAT SHELFORD PARISH COUNCIL STAFFING STRUCTURE

Currently Great Shelford Parish Council employs four members of staff.

MANAGEMENT

- 1. Individual Councillors cannot make any decisions on behalf of the council and must report back to a full council or Finance & General Purposes Committee meeting for a corporate decision.
- 2. Individual Councillors including the Chairman cannot manage staff. Please see the information in 'Being a Good Employer A Guide for Town and Parish Councils'.
- 3. Councils are not permitted to delegate management decisions under the Local Government Act 1972, s101 to individual councillors. Delegation can only be made to a committee, sub-committee, an officer of the Council or another local authority.
- 4. The HR Committee manages employment issues and reports back to full council when required under their Terms of Reference.
- 5. If relevant for a specific role, the HR Committee can invite members of another working party to assist with recruitment.
